The Brisbane Public Access Network Association Incorporated (BrisNet) would like to apply for a UUCP account on bunyip.

BrisNet aims to provide e-mail and network news service to individuals in the Brisbane area. This will be done at no profit to BrisNet.

BrisNet is already a Mail Affiliate Member with AARNet, and AARNet has accepted the goals and aims of BrisNet as being suitable for connection to AARNet.

BrisNet requires people connected to it to ensure that all traffic destined for AARNet links conform to AARNet's Acceptable Use Policy.

Monitoring programs on the BrisNet hub will monitor traffic volumes and watch for any attempts to breach AARNet's and BrisNet's policies. A copy of the BrisNet Application for Service is attached for your information.

Because all links will be via UUCP, there is no threat of 'hacking' activities common to IP networks originating from BrisNet links. Preliminary tests have indicated that a connection to bunyip can be achieved without any problems.

BrisNet has submitted all paperwork and paid all fees necessary for incorporation to the Department of Justice, however, a certificate of incorporation will take several weeks to be issued. At this stage, the BrisNet Committee is capable of entering into a legally binding agreement with other entities, and once the certificate of incorporation is issued, BrisNet Incorporated will take over all assets, liabilities and contracts.

We would like to arrange a meeting to discuss our association and apply for an affiliate feed via your services.
